WINDOW / EXTERIOR DOOR PERMIT

- A permit is required regardless of the number of windows/doors being replaced
- Submit a completed Building application.

- Recorded Notice of Commencement (if over \$2500.00).

- Completed Product Approval Specification Sheet.

- One copy of applicable Product Approval(s) with installation instructions.

- Property owner may obtain permit only when the property is not offered for sale or lease. Otherwise, a properly licensed contractor is required.
- All of Pinellas County requires wind-borne debris opening protection either,
 - Impact rated windows/doors.
 - Opening Protection Device such as approved shutters, fabric, panels.
 - If this is the choice, think about installing the device on a 2nd floor window; do I have a ladder that will reach, can I install the device while working off a ladder?
