ORDINANCE NO. 12-2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEMINOLE, FLORIDA, GRANTING TO DUKE ENERGY FLORIDA, LLC d/b/a DUKE ENERGY, AN ELECTRIC UTILITY RIGHTS OF WAY UTILIZATION FRANCHISE; PRESCRIBING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS RELATED TO THE OCCUPANCY OF THE CITY'S STREETS AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ELECTRIC SERVICE; MAKING RELATED FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Duke Energy is an electric utility within the meaning set out in Florida Statutes § 366.02(2) and a public utility as defined in Florida Statutes § 366.02(1) Section 366.02(1); and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes § 337.401 grants the City the authority to authorize the placement and maintenance, by a public electric utility, of electric transmission facilities in the City's rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, Duke Energy and the City have negotiated a franchise agreement authorizing Duke Energy to place, operate and maintain its electric transmission facilities in the City's rightsof-way pursuant to terms and conditions acceptable to both Parties; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the granting of this franchise agreement is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City's residents and businesses.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Seminole, Florida, that:

Section 1. The franchise agreement between the City of Seminole and Duke Energy,

which agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted and approved.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute any and all additional documents

as the Parties may determine are necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall not transmit this Ordinance to the codifier of the City's

ordinances for codification.

Section 4. Pursuant to Florida Statutes § 166.041(4), this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
