WHEREAS, 2-1-1 provides an on-line database of over 3,000 health and human services programs in Pinellas located on the 2-1-1 Tampa Bay Cares, Inc. website www.211tampabay.org; and

WHEREAS, 2-1-1 serves as a support system for emergency management to help disseminate critical information, assist people through disasters and provide a long-term connection to relief and recovery services;
