**WHEREAS**, the award-winning Seminole High School Marching Band is recognized for its superb musical entertainment during the event; and

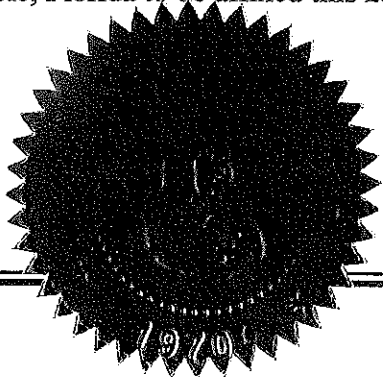
