WHEREAS, The Professional Municipal Clerk serves as the public records and information custodian for local governments, and

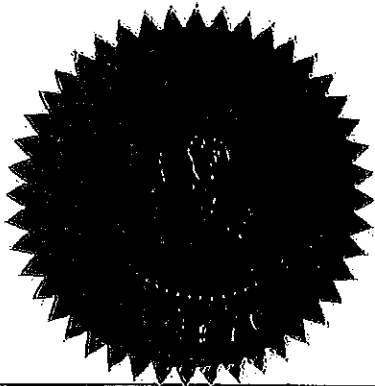
