WHEREAS, is a Service and 501 c3 Organization made up of women who support local children's and veteran's charities/causes within the Seminole and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, for the last 22 years, has provided 2 weeks-worth of food to approximately 40 Seminole families during the December school break as part of its "Share Our Spirit" canned food drive, maintains a little Library at the Treasure Island Fun Center to provide free books for Seminole children; and


