WHEREAS, his commitment to his principles, as well as his tireless energy in championing causes important to him, left an indelible mark on public discourse; and

WHEREAS, we hereby remember and honor the life and legacy of Charlie Kirk, acknowledging his impact on the lives of many and the enduring influence of his work; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seminole assures and supports that our Constitutional Rights include the freedom of speech and the safety for which to exercise said right; and

WHEREAS, today, October 14, 2025, is a National Day of Remembrance for Charlie Kirk. Today, his birthday, Charlie would have been 32 years old; and


